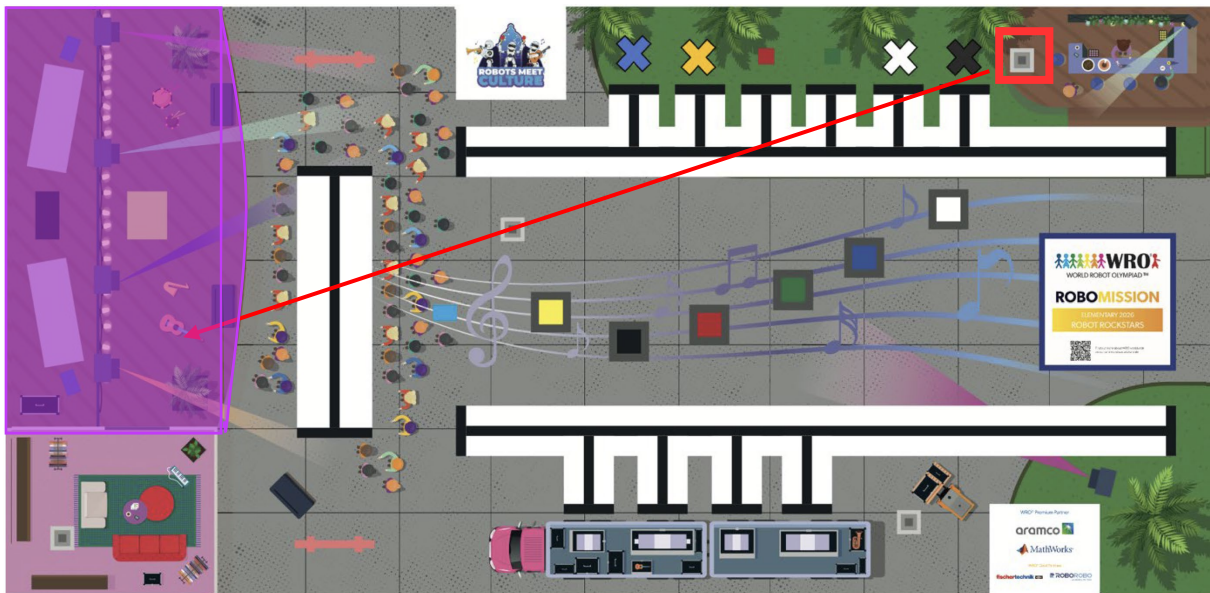


SUPPLEMENTARY TASK FOR THE SWISS FINALS

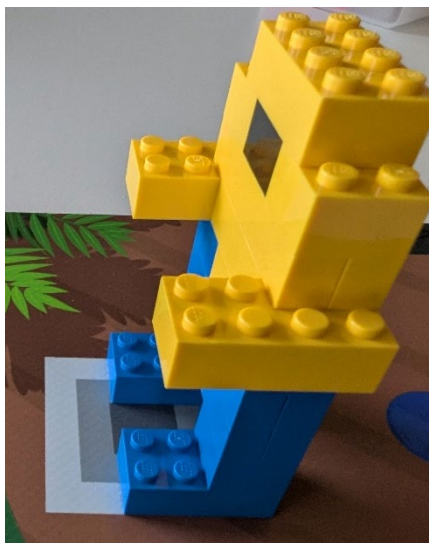

Your task: Bring the singer from the bar to the stage. The whole area marked in purple in the picture below is considered the stage.

Please note: In order to receive full points, the singer may only be placed on the stage once the cables and the microphone have been placed correctly in their respective target areas.








Positioning of the singer:



The table below shows the scoring for this supplementary task, and the photos clarify its application for the singer. Please note:

- Definition of “completely inside”: Completely means that the game object only touches the target area.

The singer is completely inside the stage area. The cables and the microphone were placed in their correct positions before the singer was brought to the stage.	20	20
The singer is completely inside the stage area. The cables and the microphone were not placed in their correct positions or were not brought to the stage before the singer.	10	10
