

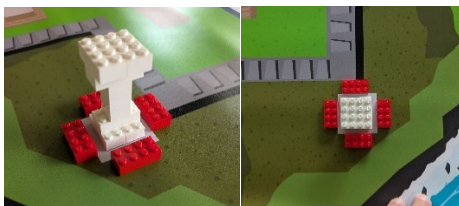
SUPPLEMENTARY TASK FOR THE SWISS FINALS

Your task: Take the bone from the excavation site into the laboratory (“Robots Meet Culture” area).







Exact positioning:



The stones (red 4x2 Lego bricks) are fixed to the game mat using double-sided tape as shown in these illustrations.

The table below shows the scoring for this supplementary task, and the photos clarify its application for the dinosaur bone. Please note:

- Definition of “completely inside”: Completely means that the game object only touches the white area with the “Robots Meet Culture” Logo.

The bone of the dinosaur is undamaged and completely inside the laboratory (“Robots Meet Culture” area).	20	20
The bone of the dinosaur is undamaged and only partially inside the laboratory (“Robots Meet Culture” area).	10	
The bone of the dinosaur has been damaged, but all parts are completely inside the laboratory (“Robots Meet Culture” area).	5	
 20 points (undamaged, completely inside, upright)	 20 points (undamaged, completely inside, lying)	
 10 points (partially inside)	 5 points (damaged, all parts completely inside)
